1640 Alameda Ave. needs cutting. Residents are complaining that rodents are coming from the house.

During neighborhood meetings residents are asking for grass at the parks to be cut more often.

1737 Cleburn has been complaining about her sidewalk and tree concerns for two years. She has someone who is elderly lives in her home and they don't need the broken up sidewalk. Districts 6 and 7 have reported this before.

1728 Center Street South. The cars are back. The residents in South Titusville have been complaining about this property for months now. They are upset that code enforcement hasn't stopped them from working on cars in the front yard, they block the road, and they play music all night long. I'm fed up and residents have had enough. Residents want action done from the City.

I have a citizen Ms. Lozetta Lowe, owns a house on 404 Gamma St, in South Titusville, she got a call that the Public Works was at her house with a bull dozer and the workers told her that they were told to remove her fence.
